Grade 1 Supply List

The Brand names suggested have proven to be better quality and last longer.

- 20 Pencils (H.B. good quality, wooden, ie: Mirado, Venus) *please sharpen
- 2 Erasers – white vinyl
- 1 Box **Laurentian or Crayola** pencil crayons (minimum 12 per pkg) *please sharpen
- 1 Box **Crayola** wax crayons (pkg of 24)
- 1 Box **Crayola Washable Markers** (pkg of 8)
- 4 Glue sticks (**Elmers or UHU Stick** brand white glue, jumbo, 21g size)
- 1 Pair of **Fiskars** scissors, metal blades with points
- 1 Small **Metal** pencil sharpener (with receptacle if possible)
- 1 Pencil box
- 1 Pair gym runners (slip-on or Velcro closing, no laces) to be kept at school (do not have to be new, but must be clean)
- 1 Box Kleenex (optional)
- 1 Bottle **LePage's or Elmers** glue
- 1 Pair of headphones for computer (in Ziploc bag labeled with name)
- 1 Full change of clothing to be left at school (pants, shirt, underwear, socks – please put in a large Ziploc bag with your child's name on bag)

There will be an additional charge of \$15.00 per student for Notebooks and Duo Tangs, etc. and \$6.00 for school planners. These will be purchased by the classroom teacher.

*Additional supplies or money may still be requested in September and during the year for additional art supplies.

Please put child's name on all clothing.

Please send all supplies in September and the teacher will keep all extras to be handed out as each child needs them.

EMERGENCY COMFORT KIT

As part of our Emergency Preparedness Plan, we ask for your co-operation in providing a Comfort Kit for your child. Each kit will consist of a few essential items which will be of great comfort to your child in the event of a disaster – primarily for the first 48 hours. Children in Kindergarten to Grade 4 particularly, may benefit from the use of a comfort kit during a disaster although all children are welcome to have one at school. The kits will be stored in the earthquake kiosk and will only be used in the event of a disaster. If unused, they will be returned to you at the end of the school year.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR CHILD BRINGS THIS KIT IN A MEDIUM ZIPLOC BAGGIE. PRINT THE CHILD'S FULL NAME AND GRADE ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE BAGGIE. THANK YOU.

- ❑ 2 nutri-bars, power bars, etc.
- ❑ 1 roll of hard candy – for use during an emergency situation only.
- ❑ 1 small toy or game
- ❑ 2 plastic garbage bags (to be worn over clothes)
- ❑ 3 plastic bread bags (to be worn over shoes)
- ❑ 1 comfort letter addressed to your child in a sealed envelope (assuring him/her that you will get to them ASAP, etc.)
- ❑ 1 pen and paper (activity for child waiting to be picked up, in case they can't re-enter the school)
- ❑ a few family pictures which are a great comfort in time of stress
- ❑ 1 solar blanket sometimes called "space blankets" which can be found at most hardware stores (looks like foil wrap – costs approximately \$3.00)
- ❑ 1 Ziploc bag (waterproof) – remember that everything must fit into this!
- ❑ 1 school photo from last year or a current and clear picture of the child. This picture should be facing out so that it can be clearly seen.
