The Brand names suggested have proven to be better quality and last longer.

- 20 Pencils (H.B. good quality, wooden eg: **Mirado, Venus**) \*Please Sharpen
  - 3 Erasers – white vinyl
  - 1 Box pencil crayons (**Laurentian** are good quality) \*Please Sharpen
  - 1 Box **Crayola** felt markers (broad tip)
  - 2 **Yellow** highlighter pens
  - 6 Glue sticks (jumbo, 21g)
  - 1 Pair of **Fiskars** scissors - metal blades with points
  - 2 Small **metal** pencil sharpener, with receptacle – Staedtler is good quality
  - 2 Pencil box, small rectangular plastic
  - 1 Plain (not lined) exercise book (23 cm x 18 cm)
  - 1 pkg. 3-hole punched, lined, loose leaf paper (100 sheets per pkg)
  - 1 PAIR GYM RUNNERS TO BE KEPT AT SCHOOL (Do not have to be new but must be clean) **NOT SKATEBOARD SHOES**
  - 1 Box Kleenex
  - 1 Headphones for computer (in Ziploc bag, labelled with name)
  - 1 4 GB USB Flash Drive (labeled with name)
  - 2 Fineliners (black fine tip, not thick Sharpies)
  - 2 Red pens for marking
- (No binders please – not used at this age)**

Additional supplies may be requested in September and during the year.

**PLEASE PUT CHILD’S NAME ON ALL SUPPLIES, CLOTHING, ETC.**

There will be an additional charge of \$10.00 per student for Notebooks and Duo Tangs and \$6.00 for school planners. **These will be purchased by the classroom teacher.**

Please send all supplies in September and the teacher will keep all extras to be handed out as each child needs them.

## EMERGENCY COMFORT KIT

As part of our Emergency Preparedness Plan, we ask for your co-operation in providing a Comfort Kit for your child. Each kit will consist of a few essential items which will be of great comfort to your child in the event of a disaster – primarily for the first 48 hours. Children in Kindergarten to Grade 4 particularly, may benefit from the use of a comfort kit during a disaster although all children are welcome to have one at school. The kits will be stored in the earthquake kiosk and will only be used in the event of a disaster. If unused, they will be returned to you at the end of the school year.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR CHILD BRINGS THIS KIT IN A MEDIUM ZIPLOC BAGGIE. PRINT THE CHILD'S FULL NAME AND GRADE ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE BAGGIE. THANK YOU.

- ❑ 2 nutri-bars, power bars, etc.
- ❑ 1 roll of hard candy – for use during an emergency situation only.
- ❑ 1 small toy or game
- ❑ 2 plastic garbage bags (to be worn over clothes)
- ❑ 3 plastic bread bags (to be worn over shoes)
- ❑ 1 comfort letter addressed to your child in a sealed envelope (assuring him/her that you will get to them ASAP, etc.)
- ❑ 1 pen and paper (activity for child waiting to be picked up, in case they can't re-enter the school)
- ❑ a few family pictures which are a great comfort in time of stress
- ❑ 1 solar blanket sometimes called "space blankets" which can be found at most hardware stores (looks like foil wrap – costs approximately \$3.00)
- ❑ 1 Ziploc bag (waterproof) – remember that everything must fit into this!
- ❑ 1 school photo from last year or a current and clear picture of the child. This picture should be facing out so that it can be clearly seen.
