Grade 7 Supply List  
2016/2017**

- 1 Pencil sharpener with receptacle
- 1 Calculator (a “must” item, but not real tiny)
- 1 Geometry kit
- 20 \*Pencils (H.B. good quality) (5 sharpened)
- 2 \*White erasers (large size)
- 3 \*Ball point pens, **RED**
- 5 \*Ball point pens, **BLUE** or **BLACK**
- 1 Pkg Looseleaf paper – 800 sheets, lined 400 at start of year and 200 term 2 then 200 term 3
- 3 \*Glue Sticks (jumbo, 21g)
- 1 Pair of scissors
- 1 Pencil box (or case)
- 1 Pkg. pencil crayons (**Laurentian, Crayola, Prang** are good quality) ***Please sharpen prior to first day of school.***
- 1 Flexible, clear plastic metric ruler, 30 cm
- 1 Pair of gym shorts, one t-shirt, and one deodorant
- 1 Pair of gym runners (non-marking soles) to be kept at school (Do not have to be new but must be clean) **NOT SKATEBOARD SHOES**
- 3 Fineliners (black, fine tip)
- 2 Highlighters – yellow
- 1 2” (or larger) Note Tote Binder (with pockets & zipper)
- 1 alphabetical set of binder dividers
- 2 large Ziploc bags (for keeping extra pens, pencils, etc. by teacher)
- 2 4GB or higher USB Flash Drive

Items with \* beside must have child’s name on and placed in a bag to be distributed by teacher when needed.

***There will be an additional charge of \$10.00 for duotangs and 3 ring exercise books and \$6.00 for school planners. These will be purchased by the classroom teacher.***

Additional supplies may be requested early in September.

## **EMERGENCY COMFORT KIT**

As part of our Emergency Preparedness Plan, we ask for your co-operation in providing a Comfort Kit for your child. Each kit will consist of a few essential items which will be of great comfort to your child in the event of a disaster – primarily for the first 48 hours. Children in Kindergarten to Grade 4 particularly, may benefit from the use of a comfort kit during a disaster although all children are welcome to have one at school. The kits will be stored in the earthquake kiosk and will only be used in the event of a disaster. If unused, they will be returned to you at the end of the school year.

**PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR CHILD BRINGS THIS KIT IN A MEDIUM ZIPLOC BAGGIE. PRINT THE CHILD'S FULL NAME AND GRADE ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE BAGGIE. THANK YOU.**

- ❑ 2 nutri-bars, power bars, etc.
- ❑ 1 roll of hard candy – for use during an emergency situation only.
- ❑ 1 small toy or game
- ❑ 2 plastic garbage bags (to be worn over clothes)
- ❑ 3 plastic bread bags (to be worn over shoes)
- ❑ 1 comfort letter addressed to your child in a sealed envelope (assuring him/her that you will get to them ASAP, etc.)
- ❑ 1 pen and paper (activity for child waiting to be picked up, in case they can't re-enter the school)
- ❑ a few family pictures which are a great comfort in time of stress
- ❑ 1 solar blanket sometimes called "space blankets" which can be found at most hardware stores (looks like foil wrap – costs approximately \$3.00)
- ❑ 1 Ziploc bag (waterproof) – remember that everything must fit into this!
- ❑ 1 school photo from last year or a current and clear picture of the child. This picture should be facing out so that it can be clearly seen.
