# **LUNCHTIME PROCEDURES**

Students will be dismissed for lunch recess at 11:45 am and return to class at 12:21 pm to eat lunch. In some cases, teachers may choose to have children eat lunch prior to the recess break. There is no inside supervision at lunch recess. As a result, all students are expected to go outside for the duration of lunch recess. We are outside for lunch and morning recess rain or shine, unless the weather is quite severe. Students should come to school with adequate outer clothing to comfortably remain outside during these breaks.

Students are not permitted to leave the school grounds during the noon recess without permission from their teacher(s) and also with written parental permission. This is typically permission to go home for lunch. We do not allow students to visit the store during recess.
