#### SCHOOL CLOSURES

As we approach the winter weather it is always important to remind families about the process to determine if schools are closed.

If schools are closed due to snow, or any other weather-related problems, announcements will be made on local radio stations (WOLF 106.9 FM, WAVE 102.3 FM, and 91.7 COAST FM) by 7 a.m. on the day of the closure. Please do not call the radio station – tune in and listen for the announcements, which will be made on a regular basis.



In addition, the district will post the information on the district's website, Twitter, Facebook and mobile app. Families may also receive a message through the School Messenger notification system via phone, email or text. Please keep in mind, however, that there may be situations where this is not always possible, for example, power outages or technical problems. The most reliable method is to listen to the local radio stations.

We would like to remind parents that it is their right to make the final decision as to whether it is safe for their children to travel to school on any given day. While the district strives to make the best decision possible for students across the district, there may be circumstances in your neighbourhood that lead you to decide to keep your children home, even though schools are open.

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# School Registration 2023-2024

To register your child in Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools, the online, centralized **registration will begin on January 4, 2023 at 8 a.m.** Pacific Standard Time. The following information will help determine if this process will apply to you.

Take a moment and ask yourself the following questions:

- 1. Is my child new to Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools?
- 2. Do I have a child that will be turning five years old on or before December 31, 2023 that will be entering Kindergarten? Applications must be received by June 15, 2023 to ensure a placement in your child's catchment-area school.
- 3. Do I want to register my child in Late French Immersion for Grade 6? Late French Immersion Students are placed as space permits.
- 4. Do I want to register my child in Early French Immersion? Applications will be received until January 31, 2023, at which time student selection will be determined by lottery. Parents will be notified in early February 2023.

5. Do I want to register my child in secondary academies? Lottery Try-outs/ Audition
